

Scholarship Guidelines

1) The Scholarship Chairman and Committee are responsible for raising funds for the Meadows Home & Garden Club Scholarship Award(s). The committee will select recipient(s) from the qualifying applications submitted . The Club will vote on the amounts to be awarded annually if funds are available.

2) Each year before February 20th, Scholarship applications will be delivered to Dulles High School (counselor) and to Meadows Place City Hall for applicants. Remember to submit information in the City Newsletter in March where applicants can receive applications and the April 30th deadline for receiving applications.

3) The applications should be sent to the Scholarship Chairman. All applications must be postmarked no later than April 30th. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

4) The Chairman and Committee will select the recipient(s) meeting the eligibility requirements.

Applicants must be a resident of Meadows Place, Texas

A U.S. citizen or have permanent residency status.

Current high school senior planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at an accredited U.S. college or university

Or current post-secondary education student planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at an accredited U.S. college or university.

Adult residents who have been out of the work force and wish to pursue and education will also be considered.

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, potential to succeed, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of education and career goals, unusual personal or family circumstances and outside appraisal.

Keep in mind all students who might need assistance, no matter what their grade point, will be considered. We often choose the average student over the above average in grades due to their need and desire to attend college.

5) All applicants will be notified in May. The Chairman will send a letter notifying the selected recipient of their selection, amount of the award and the date award will be presented at Meadows Place City Council meeting in May. Chairman will also send letters of regret to the other applicants.

6) Call City Hall first week in May to be placed on the Agenda for the May Meadows Place City Council meeting for the presentation of the Award.

7) Make sure recipient understands when they register for school they must request that the registrar's office send a letter to the Chairman which confirms their enrollment for the summer or fall semester. Once we receive this confirmation a check in the amount awarded will be sent to the school.
